

Mounting Images for Display – A Quick Guide

1. Mount Sizes

The size of mount must be adequate for the print being displayed.

A common size used in all Clubs is a mount size of 50cm x 40cm this is size used by EAF.

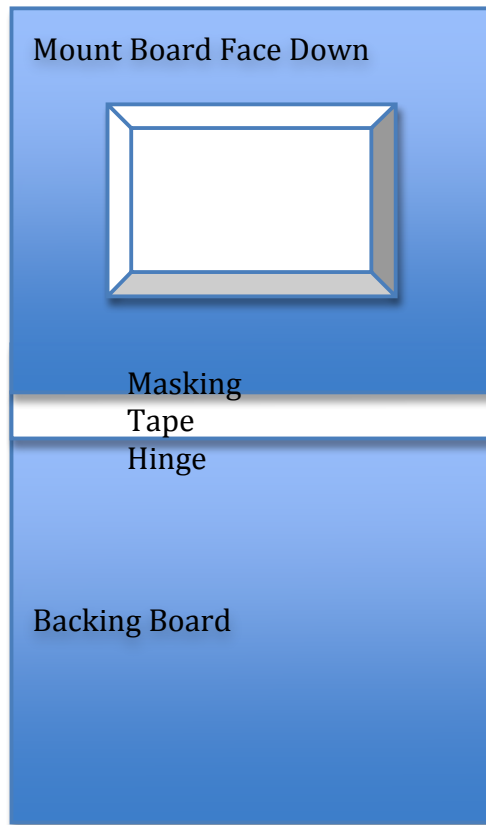
BUT **Pre cut mounts are available in Craft Shops for A4 size prints.**

2. Cut Mount Board and Backing Card to size:



3. On Mount Board cut the opening for the image. **Cut this smaller than the paper size.**

5. Place the mount board face down with the backing sheet and tape along the top edge with masking tape to form a hinge

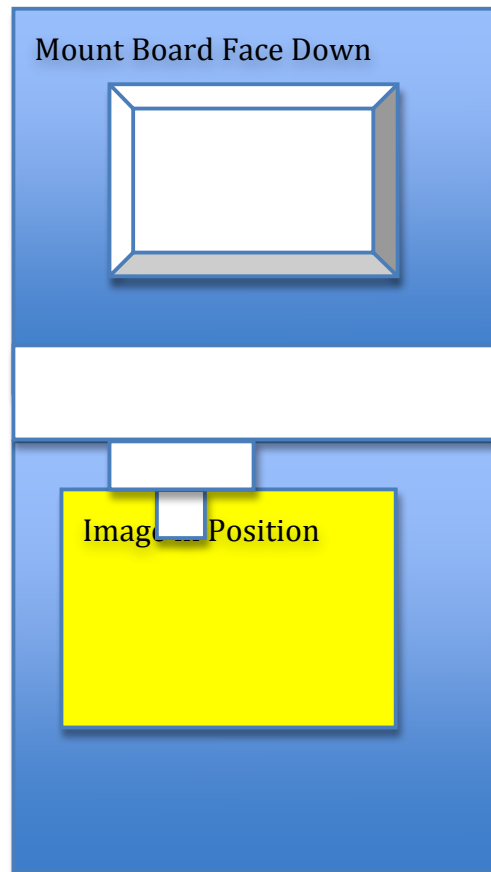


6. Place image Face Up on BACKING BOARD

7. Flip Mount Board Over and align the image.

8. Protect the Image and weight down in position

9. Lift Mount Board Up being careful not to move image and carefully tape the Image in place **Lightly** with a “T” Shape. Slide one piece of tape **under** the image and then another piece **across the top**.



10 Check the alignment by folding over mount board adjust taping etc as required

11. Firm up the image with Tape as required

12. Flip over mount board and secure to backing board

13. Label Print with

1. Club Name
2. Your Name
3. Image Title
4. Mono or Colour.
